Town of Seven Devils Parks and Recreation Committee Minutes - Regular Session April 11, 2024

The Town of Seven Devils Parks and Recreation Committee met at 9:00 AM in Town Hall on April 11, 2024. Members present were: Marino Fernandez, Freddie Blonshine and Rebecca Ryan. Also in attendance was Jewel McKinney, Parks and Recreation Director. Citizens in attendance were Mary Ballinger, Henry Williams, Wayne Bonomo, Tom Bookstaver and Larry Fontaine. Sarah Brendle, Faye Brock, Ed Beck, Joe Alfonso, Theresa Lindgren and Kay Lambert were absent.

Freddie Blonshine moved to approve the Agenda, and Rebecca Ryan seconded. The motion was approved.

Rebecca Ryan moved to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2024 meeting. Marino Fernandez seconded. The motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS

- **A.** T-Shirt Update Jewel McKinney reported that sales of the t-shirts will be run through the TDA. The TDA is asking for volunteers to sell the shirts at summer events.
- **B.** Lecture Series Marino Fernandez reported that there will be three lectures by Appalachian State Professors this summer in June, July and August. There was also an idea presented to pair some of the talent of Seven Devils residents with an App State student for mentoring. Marino will pursue this idea.
- C. Summer 2024 Events
 - Draft Rack Card With Confirmed Events Jewel McKinney presented a newly designed Rack Card for 2024. It is pamphlet style, with one page for each month of June, July and August. The Committee approved of the new design. There will be two CPR Lunch and Learn classes taught by Fire Chief Matt Millsaps. There will also be a First Aid class in July. A Yoga instructor has been found. Jewel McKinney is addressing the crack in the Pickleball courts.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Jewel McKinney has a quote to repair the Otter Falls trestle. It was noted that the signs need repainting. The trash situation is much better.

CITIZEN COMMENTS -

- A. Mayor Larry Fontaine reported that he and the Town Engineer met with officials of the State of North Carolina regarding funds for water and road repairs. There could possibly be \$8,000,000 in funds for water repair and updates and \$1,000,000 in funds for paving all unpaved roads. Mayor Fontaine also reported that construction of the playground, dog park and par course will start as soon as the weather allows. Bid packages will be sent out on the stage, pavilion and bathroom, hopefully to break ground next year on these items. Naming the stage in memorial after Bob Bridges has been approved by Town Council.
- B. Mary Ballinger noted that the Otter Falls sign by the Community Center needs repainting. She also suggested an activity where Seven Devils musicians could meet for an informal gathering of music. Jewel McKinney will send out an email to gauge interest.
