The Town of Seven Devils Planning Board reviewed a request from Mr. Lenny Cottom on September 20, 2022, to rezone the following five parcels of property.

- High Density Residential (HDR) to Low Density Residential (LDR) 3 parcels for a total of 17.32 ac Owner / Applicant – Leonard and Denise Cottom Action – Unanimously Approved
- Recreation Business (RB) to Medium Density Residential (MDR) 25.5 ac
 Owner/Applicant Hanging Rock Golf Club, Lenny Cottom
 Action Denied (3-1 vote) Unfavorable Recommendation
- Recreation Business High Density Residential 21.23 ac.
 Owner /Applicant -Hawksnest Zipline Inc. Lenny Cottom
 Action Unanimously Denied Unfavorable Recommendation

The applicant had submitted a previous application for rezoning on August 16 requesting 38 acres, which included property in above referenced item 1 combined with item 2 be changed from Recreation Business to Medium Density Residential along with item 3, (RB – HDR) which could possibly add 150 single-family dwellings. The board denied the rezoning request (3-1 vote). The applicant withdrew the request from consideration by the Town Council and resubmitted a new request as referenced in items 1-3 above, which reduced the density to 116 possible single-family dwellings.

The Planning Board did recommend an alternative motion to item 3, noted as 3 alpha in the Planning Board minutes. This motion was to recommend approval of approximately 15 acres of the 21.23 acres of item 3 be rezoned to High Density Residential (HDR) to offset the rezoning change of item 1 where the applicant is reducing the HDR to LDR, thereby reducing the density of 6 homes per acre to 1 home per acre which is a reduction of 85 dwellings, pursuant to the applicant going forward with the zoning change for item 1.

Pursuant to NC General Statutes and the Town of Seven Devils Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) a public hearing with two (2) successive weeks of public notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the jurisdiction, with a minimum of 10 days' notice but not more than 25 days must be held to receive public comment on the above referenced request. The Town Council is not bound by the Planning Board recommendations.

High Country ABC Board Meeting Minutes October 18, 2022 via ZOOM & In-person

The High Country ABC Board (Board) held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at 5:00 pm via ZOOM and in-person. Board Chair Anne Fontaine; Board Member Donna Dicks; Board Member Winston Ammann (ZOOM); Alternate Board Members Robin Dunn, Leigh Sasse; Seven Devil's Town manager, Jonathan Harris; Brady Combs, CPA; General Manager Bonnie Betz were present. Alternate Board Member David Miller was absent.

In advance of the meeting, Board Chair Anne Fontaine read the following conflict of interest statement: "In accordance with 18B-201, it is the duty of every Board Member to avoid both conflicts of interest and appearances of conflicts. Does any Board Member have any conflicts of interests or appearances of conflicts with matters coming before the Board today?" Hearing none, the meeting commenced.

Upon a motion duly made by Winston Ammann and seconded by Donna Dicks, it was voted to approve the October 18, 2022 agenda. Upon a motion duly made by Donna Dicks and seconded by Winston Ammann, it was voted to approve the minutes of the September 15, 2022 Board meeting.

The General Manager reported that total sales for the month of September 2022 were \$452,757. Sales were up \$9,010 over last year's sales of \$443,747. Retail sales for September were \$334,889, down \$8,328. However, mixed beverage sales for September were up \$17,338 for a total of \$117,868.

The General Manager reported that the available balance in the business checking account at First National Bank is \$330,459. The money market account balance is \$488,117.

Due to rising interest rates, upon motion duly made by Donna Dicks and seconded by Winston Ammann, it was voted to approve the withdrawal of \$250,000 from the money market account and move the funds into the following CDs: \$50,000 to a six-month CD at the rate of 3.25%, \$50,000 to a nine-month CD at the rate of 3.42%, and \$150,000 to a 12-month CD at the rate of 3.58%.

Currency deposited fees are now in place for all banks. The fee at the store's bank for the first \$75,000 cash deposited in a month is \$0.10/\$100. The next tier goes to \$125,000 and the fee drops down to \$.09/\$100. The interest rate that we are currently receiving on the money market account is 1% and has been covering the fee. In September we received \$381.18 in interest on the money market account. The currency fee was \$52.66.

Upon a motion duly made by Winston Ammann and seconded by Donna Dicks, it was voted to do a budget amendment to decrease \$75,000 from the appropriated fund balance and to increase \$75,000 to the Towns disbursements.

Old Business:

The Board decided not to fund the Western Youth Network's Festival of Trees fundraiser but to support one of their other programs that is focused on alcohol education. The General Manager will send a grant application to their contact, Tiffany Moon, and inform her that she can submit multiple grant requests if alcohol education fits in several different programs. The Board would like the General Manager to reach out to all the other grant recipients and ask them to give a quarterly update on how their programs are doing utilizing the grant money they received from the Board.

New Business:

Brady Combs, with Combs, Tenant and Carpenter, attended the October Board meeting to discuss the audit report and answered questions the Board had. The High Country ABC Store had a good audit and there were no budget findings. Mr. Combs commented that the store is doing very good and is well managed. There is a balance from last year's budget of \$6,661 in alcohol education and a balance of \$1,331 in law enforcement that needs to be paid out according to NC ABC Commission laws. Upon a motion duly made by Donna Dicks and seconded by Winston Ammann, it was voted to increase \$6,661 to alcohol education and \$1,331 to law enforcement for an additional total of \$7,992 to this year's budget line items to make these payments.

Mr. Combs provided documentation on the formula requirements of the Commission on how to calculate the amounts needed for alcohol education and

law enforcement to be spent. He will add these spreadsheets to our monthly financials so that the Board can determine compliance and meet all requirements.
