

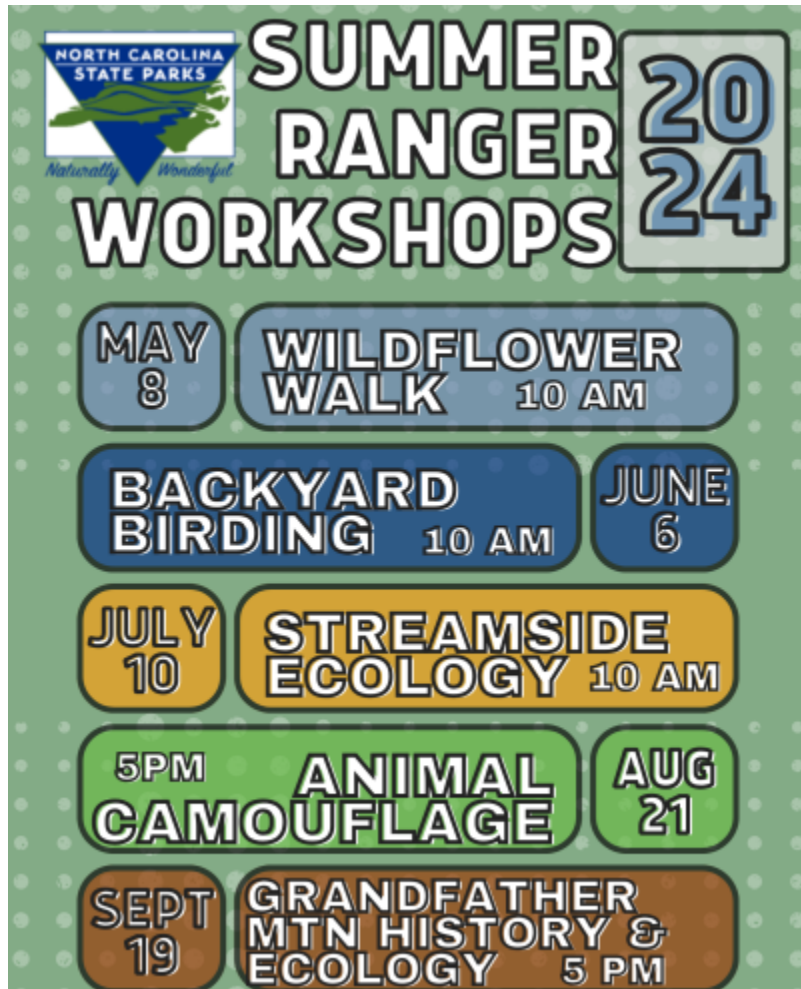
Ranger Workshop - Wildflower Walk
