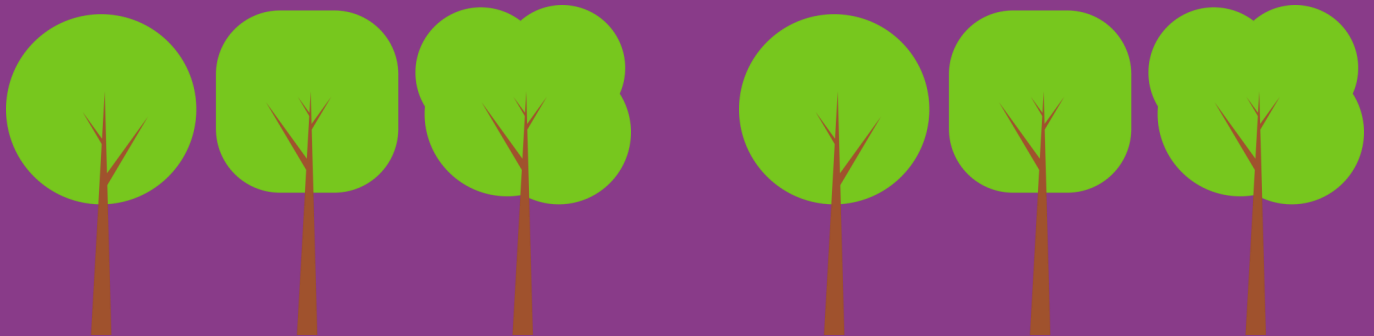
Summer 2016 Edition
