

**TOWN OF SEVEN DEVILS  
TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES – REGULAR MEETING**

**July 12, 2016**

The Seven Devils Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, July 12, 2016, at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Larry Fontaine, Mayor Pro Tem Brad Lambert, Council Members David Hooper, and David Ehmig. Member Kay Ehlinger was absent. Also present were Town Attorney Rob Angle and Town Manager Debbie Powers. The minutes were recorded by Sara Miller, Town Clerk.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Fontaine called the meeting to order at 5:30PM.

**ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATE**

Manager Powers gave a summary of the administrative update. She stated that the Town tennis courts were being resurfaced, painted, and striped, thanks to TDA funding. She also stated that the TDA had ordered two new pieces of playground equipment that would be coming soon.

A generous citizen donated \$500 to the Public Safety Department. Manager Powers stated that the citizen was very thankful for the service they provided for them over the busy July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend.

Manager Powers stated that the Police Department had received their body cameras and that they were already being used. Police Chief Chuck Davis had drafted a regulatory policy for the cameras, but until State legislation was finalized, it would not be officially approved by the Council.

Moretz Paving was currently in Town working on the approved paving projects. Manager Powers stated that they hoped, weather permitting, to finish by the end of the week.

**SEVEN DEVILS PARKS AND RECREATION ORDINANCE**—Mayor Fontaine stated that the Public Safety Department and the Town as a whole would benefit from having a parks and recreation type ordinance. He stated that the ordinance would give authority to the Public Safety officers to handle issues that arise on Town owned land and parks immediately. Manager Powers stated that a draft of a parks and recreation ordinance would be better as a stand-alone ordinance, and would need to go through the Planning Board before coming to the Council for approval.
