

**Orange Route—East—1.2 Miles** 🥾🥾

This walking route is a loop that can be taken either clockwise or counterclockwise. It leads through cool forests, and in many places the road is lined with walls of native rhododendrons, especially beautiful when blooming in July. You will see beds of ferns and wild flowers. There are also outstanding views of Grandfather Mountain.

To start your walk, park on the wide grassy shoulder on Devils Lake Drive near the intersection of Devils Lake Drive and Valley View Road.
