OLD BUSINESS

Seven Devils Tenth Annual SafetyFest - July 6, 2013

- \* Kay Lambert reported that one major raffle prize has been purchased for under \$100. Sponsor request packets have been sent out.
- \* George Ehlinger reported that he has lined up five placemat ads. Kay Lambert has two.
- \* It was reported that Bobby Powell has lined up the ladder truck, smoke house and squirt house.
- \* We looked over mock-ups of the raffle ticket. A few questions were asked and George Ehlinger will check with Kay Ehlinger/Blue Horse Promotions.
- \* Kay Lambert reported that we will have the Pepsi Wagon.
- \* Ed Evans suggested that we see if Freeman Gas will donate the propane for the tanks for the 2013-2014 tax year (after July 1, 2013). George Ehlinger will also talk with Fanners Rental about the possibility of propane.

- B. Reflectors - Dick Nelson and Earl Pariseau voiced their concerns about difficulty seeing the road edge in the fog. They suggested reflectors either on the road or alongside or painting the roadway edges. After much discussion the Committee unanimously voted to pass the matter onto the Public Works Committee for further review and study.
- C. 911 in an emergency - Brad Lambert emphasized the need for people to call 911 in an emergency, not the Seven Devils Public Safety Officer on duty. Time is crucial in fire and medical emergencies and 911 permits the fastest response time.

Brad Lambert moved to adjourn the meeting. Earl Pariseau seconded. All members agreed. The meeting was adjourned at 6:40pm.
