B. The desire for reflectors or white lines painted on road edges was addressed and discussed again. Fog can be problematic on curves especially. A study was made in April by the Public Works Committee. Cost was out of sight. No affordable solution has been offered. Brad Lambert offered to discuss it with Ed Evans, Town Manager.

Citizen Comments: Concern has been voiced by Blair Estate residents concerning encroachment on their property and green space. People have trespassed and parked helter skelter in an effort to go to Otter Falls. The Town does not own Otter Falls yet and it is posted "No Trespassing". People, some who are potential donors to the Otter Falls aquisition, feel they have the right to see the property and are ignoring posted signs. Also - what is the plan for access to Otter Falls once the property becomes a part of the Town of Seven Devils? Brad Lambert and David Hooper will discuss this further with Ed Evans and members of the Town Council.
