

**Town of Seven Devils  
Recreation Commission  
Minutes—Regular Session  
October 11, 2018**

The Town of Seven Devils Recreation Commission met at 9:00 a.m. in Town Hall on October 11, 2018. Members present were Ed Beck, Anne Fontaine, Kay Lambert, and Martha Stearns. Bob Bridges and Skip Watts were absent. Debbie Powers and Larry Fontaine were also present.

Ed Beck made a motion to accept the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes from the September 13, 2018, meeting. Kay Lambert seconded the motion, and the agenda and the minutes were approved.

Anne Fontaine said that she and Debbie Powers had discussed changing the name of the Recreation Commission to Parks and Recreation Committee, which is the term used in grant applications. Kay Lambert made a motion to approve the name change. Martha Stearns seconded the motion, and it passed.

Light the Night will be held on November 30, 2018. It will be a covered dish dinner, and we will ask participants to bring non-perishable food to be donated to a food bank.

According to Helga Sappington's financial report for The Hawk, revenues were \$3968.00, and expenses were \$2470.55. Ed Beck made a motion to donate \$500 to Samaritan's Purse's Hurricane Relief Fund. Kay Lambert seconded the motion, and it passed.

Only women's Hawk shirts are left, and Anne Fontaine will explore the possibility of donating them to Girls on the Run.

Sign-ups for the 2018 Hawk were disappointing, and we will decide at a future meeting whether or not to continue it.

We decided to adopt the proposals that Bob Bridges made at the September meeting about the summer concerts:

1. To increase the maximum performance fee from \$1250 to \$1500 per performance, subject to negotiation for a lesser amount.
2. To increase the sound engineer/sound system fee from \$450 to \$500 per performance.
3. To omit a September concert because of darkness at the end of the concert, having concerts only in June, July, and August or having one concert in June, two in July, and one in August.
4. To have a police presence on the property from thirty minutes before the concert to thirty minutes after the concert.
5. To consider having concerts of different genres.

Anne Fontaine announced that term limits are ending for Ed Beck, Kay Lambert, Martha Stearns, and Skip Watts. She urged them to fill out applications for another term. Lee Metzger has submitted an application and will join the Parks and Recreation Committee.

Our next regular Recreation Commission meeting will be at 9:00 on January 10, 2019.

Ed Beck made a motion to adjourn. Kay Lambert seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned.
